

**EYFS Autumn Term 2018 Summary. Ash and Beech.  
Themes: Marvellous Me and Christmas**

Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<p>To get to know new class members and staff. To feel comfortable in a new environment. To develop self-help skills e.g. sorting book bags, doing up our coats, collecting and eating our lunch, changing for P.E. and the copse. To develop awareness of the school rules and safety.</p>
Communication and Language	<p>To speak clearly in a small group. To be able to listen carefully. To follow instructions when asked.</p>
Literacy	<p>To use mark making tools effectively. To begin to learn new phoneme sounds in phonics. To know that books are read from left to right. To handle books appropriately. To begin to read words.</p>
Maths	<p>To count accurately and recognise numerals to 10 and above where appropriate. To explore number representation in play. To begin to recognise and name 2D shapes. To work in groups on play based maths tasks</p>
Understanding the World	<p>To explore our new school environment. To talk about things I am good at and things I enjoy doing. Talk about family celebrations and customs. Thinking about the different people who help us at home, at school and out and about. To use age-appropriate technology in the classroom.</p>
Physical Development	<p>To move safely within the school environment. To control wheeled vehicles. To use a variety of large and small apparatus with confidence and safety. To use a variety of mark-making tools to record some of our experiences. To hold a pencil with a comfortable grip and begin to form letters in our name.</p>
Expressive Arts and Design	<p>To play alongside other children engaged in the same theme. To construct with a purpose in mind. To sing rhymes and create rhythms. To explore paint, glue, dough, and collage materials to create a variety of art work. To respond to a variety of stimuli for dance, drama and musical activities.</p>
