Key Stage One

Autumn Term 2019

Term Themes: Continents and countries, Famous People: Guy Fawkes

SUBJECT:	
English	Fiction: Stories with repeating patterns. Traditional tales. Non-Fiction: Explanation texts, Recount, Captions and Labels Poetry Speaking & Listening – show & tell, stories and discussions. Reading – sounds, letter names, alphabetical order, high frequency words, reading with expression & understanding. Grammar Comprehension Handwriting
Maths	Positional language and sequencing - Understanding direction and turns. Count & read numbers to 20, and to 100 and beyond. Count on and back in 1's and 10's. Estimating and comparing. Place value. Time – estimating, sequencing and comparing months, days of the week and seasons of the year. Addition, subtraction, finding missing numbers and partitioning. Recognise coins of different values. Compare lengths, mass and heights. Read scales, measuring using non-standard measurements, metres, centimetres, kilograms and litres using appropriate equipment. Problem solving. Mental maths, knowing and using number facts including 2,5 and 10 times tables (year 2) and number bonds to 10 and 20.
Science	Animals including Humans Seasonal Changes/outdoor learning (Additional pair of outdoor shoes /boots needed in order to access all areas of the school) Working scientifically
Computing	E-safety. Explore digital texts, creating digital content (still image, word and sound) using a range of devices and software. Develop an understanding of some of the devices they use and apply some unplugged programming approaches to support their understanding.
R.E. P.S.H.E. Citizenship	Beliefs and Practices. Celebrations including Harvest, Diwali and Christmas Growing together, learning together Circle time.
History / Geography	Famous People: Guy Fawkes. Trip to The Gunpowder Mills 18/11/19 Countries and Continents The UK
Art/ Design & Technology / Music	Portraits. Colour mixing. Looking at work from famous artists. Christmas art. Recorders, long and short sounds (year 2). Use of the voice in music and sharing song.
P.E.	Gymnastics – exploring sequences of actions/ apparatus Dance – body actions – singly and in groups. Yoga Games – distributing, receiving and aiming skills (trainers needed for outside)
