Term Theme: The Anglo-Saxons

SUBJECT:	
English	Non-fiction – Reports, recounts, instructions. Fiction- Fables, play scripts. Poetry - Kennings A range of grammar incorporated into the above text types.
Maths	Developing number and place value to 4 digit numbers. Mental strategies for addition and subtraction. Fractions and scaling. Angles and Lines
Science	Sound, understanding how sound travels and how it is changed in pitch and volume. Electricity, how to create an electrical circuit and make it effective. Electrical safety.
Computing	Children discuss computer networks including the internet and the services it offers. They explore how search engines work and what influences results. They learn about the threat from computer viruses and develop understanding of intellectual property. They use spreadsheet software to create graphs and to explore number patterns.
R.E. P.S.H.E. Citizenship	Aspiration, Respect Christmas. Beliefs and practices, symbols and actions
History / Geography	Anglo-Saxons theme will involve: Creating timelines, homes and life in the past compared to present day, settlements and invaders.
Art/ Design & Technology / Music	Sketching techniques and drawing from real life. Harvest music. Christmas concert. Sutton Hoo helmet.
