Autumn Term 2019

Term Theme: Stone Age to Iron Age

SUBJECT:	
English	Fiction: Myths and Legends. Non-Fiction: Report writing Poetry: Riddles and humorous poetry, including free verse and vocabulary building. Learning common spelling patterns and rules.
Maths	Place value up to four digit numbers. Rounding numbers. Addition and Subtraction: Mental and written strategies of numbers up to 4 digits. Multiplying and Dividing: Mental strategies using times tables. Classifying 2D shapes. Completing symmetrical patterns. Finding perimeter. Identify and compare angles. Fractions recognised and use fractions of numbers, equivalent fractions. Represent data in bar graphs. Solving problems presented in other graphs.
Science	States of Matter- Understanding the properties of solids, liquids and gases and how they change and the water cycle. Skeletons and muscles.
Computing	Developing Communication - Blogging and emails. Internet Safety.
R.E. P.S.H.E. Citizenship	Beliefs and Practices linked to Sikhism and Christianity. Christmas and advent. Value – Together – working together, learning together.
History / Geography	Stone Age theme will include: Creating timelines, homes and life in the past compared to present day. Changes in Britain up to the Iron Age.
Art/ Design & Technology / Music	Art –use first hand observation, experience and imagination, to explore the roles and purposes of artists, craftspeople and designers working in different times and cultures. D&T –To explain clearly what they are trying to produce showing control of the materials, and meeting the design brief. Music- Songs to celebrate Harvest To prepare for the Christmas concert
P.E.	Games – Playground games and team games. Ball skills
French	Introduction and revision of numbers and greetings. Preferences and hobbies.
