Overall, since the implementation of the Sports Premium Grant the standards of PE provision have risen. The quality and expertise of staff delivering sports has increased and the breadth of sports offered to a wider range of pupils has risen considerably.

Pupils have had access to a quality and range of sports that could not have been provided without the funding. As well as our focus on sport for all we also have a wide range of teams and enter all possible area tournaments, with our Head serving as secretary for the local sports partnership.
