

To all our families – even if your child is going into the building as part of the critical workers group. If your child is in for certain days of the week only this will also apply to you on the days they are at home. It may also be needed if there are any periods of isolation or illness (as long as they are well enough to work !)

We do not mind what paper is used, but if it would help please collect one exercise book and a pencil, if needed, from a box that will be outside the front entrance, in the porch, every day between 9am and 12 noon. There may be a random selection of exercise books so any will suffice and all home learning can be completed in the same book.

We are aware that each family may have their own challenges and we will be as supportive and as flexible as possible in order continue to deliver learning to our children. However, children are expected to complete lessons and tasks as if at school, with the aim being that we will continue to learn at the same rate, on our planned curriculum when we return. Therefore, we have developed a set of guidance regarding our expectations and how we intend to manage online learning for this period of time:

- The learning for the day will be added to the Class Pages on the Roselands website: <https://www.roselands.herts.sch.uk/54/classes> before 9 am.
- It may be uploaded the evening before or in the morning depending on staff teaching/ other commitments. Please work one day behind if it suits you and your family to do so. All will stay on the class pages for two days.
- This daily learning will consist of English and Maths, plus one other subject.
- Whenever possible, we will add the answers/mark schemes to the Class Pages. When marking Home Learning, please use a different coloured pen or pencil so that it stands out clearly.
- Please photograph completed, marked work and send it to the class email address once you have finished all of the pieces set for that day.
- We realise that not all families have access to a printer, therefore it is absolutely fine to work on paper and send us a photograph of your completed work.
- Please also read any books you have at home, access TTRockstars or Numbots and work through your Study Guides if you are in Year 6.
- Please ensure your work is clearly labelled with your name, the date and all questions numbered, and tables are drawn with a ruler and pencil.
- We expect that the standards that are set at school to be the same when you are working from home, e.g. neatness, accuracy, quality of vocabulary and spellings.
- Whilst we will be checking our emails regularly, you may not have a response the same day.
- As some adults will be working in school, emails may be responded to by another member from your child's phase.
- Ash and Beech Class will continue to use Tapestry to set and receive work. Please see Tapestry memo.
