

UPDATE TO FAMILIES WHOSE CHILDREN ARE LEARNING AT HOME FRIDAY 8th January 7am

Good morning to all !

Thank you so much for all of the learning that you are doing and for emailing it back to us at your class addresses.

If you can email all, or even some of the learning completed, it is better on a daily basis. By adding work to the class pages each morning, and receiving it back from families daily, we hope that a routine will be established and that children complete work each day, to a better standard than if they completed lots in one session. We aim to have work set up by 9am every day, often before. Timing may be effected by staff changing between school and home learning on different days, as well as the frequent team communication within each phase.

We appreciate how difficult it is for some families to access and organise learning first thing in the morning, so the previous day's activities are always left for a day, enabling uploading and printing to take place if required at a time that best fits in with your family and other competing demands.

Stationery is available in the school porch every day between 10am and 12 noon.

The book trolley will be out every Wednesday between 10am and 12 noon.

We are in the process of developing resources further and will have more news very soon:

Google Meet will be introduced for face to face contacts.

Further CPG workbooks will be available for children to use, especially where on line access and printing is difficult, or as an alternative, preferred or additional way of working for some of our children.

Some families and staff have already been in contact and these have been packaged and collected.

As well as the daily learning activities, don't forget to encourage reading, including the Study Guides for Year Six pupils and have a go at some of the additional activities, also on the Class Pages.

We urge those families who haven't made contact yet to email their class teachers using their class email addresses as soon as possible. This is so we hear from you and know you are OK – Even if your message is 'Hello – We have

If we haven't heard from you at all by the end of today we will give you a call to check in at the beginning of next week.

We hope that you are all keeping safe and well and finally, please do ring into the school office leaving your preferred contact number if you cannot access the online learning or have any questions.
