#### Update to Families Regarding Remote Learning Procedures

Thank you to all of the families who have sent work in – we are very proud of everyone's efforts!

However, we do also understand the challenges that families are facing, with regards to juggling their own employment, working from homes, alongside their efforts at home schooling. Therefore, please find some clarification and ideas, which we have discussed as a school and which we hope will ease the burden and be reassuring at this time. We are still only just in week 2 and always aim to adjust processes as necessary.

- We are happy to accept a sample of work or even the piece your child is most proud of for that day or week, if the returning of work via email daily is a challenge. Please just state what work your pupil has completed so we know.
- Similarly, if not all of the work has been completed, for that day or week, we do understand and very much appreciate that you and your family are doing your best – we know there may be issues around sharing bandwidth and access to screens alongside the time that you are able to support your child/children if they get `stuck` or need a gentle encouragement to get on, or you may not be familiar or very confident with what they are learning – the list could go on!
- Also, any learning linked to The Oak National Academy does not require a worksheet and children can respond to this on any piece of paper available to them (stationery is available from school). Please don't worry if you cannot print a worksheet – if possible you could copy it off the screen onto another piece of paper? Or just write the answers onto a piece of paper. For some classes your teacher may signpost you to an appropriate page in the CPG books which we will be providing families with soon, or some have already requested.
- The CPG workbooks are best used by finding the section that links to the activities on the class pages for the day. They may not tie in exactly, but it is advisable to keep to a related task or activity, if you are using them, rather than working straight through them. We are just waiting for the current orders to arrive and will let you know how and when to collect them, if you don't have them already. This information is likely to be different for each phase of the school and will be sent out separately very soon. It doesn't include our EYFS children who also use Tapestry.
- This is a learning process for all of us and we appreciate your support as we continue to endeavour to make our `Remote Learning` the best it can be. Please however do keep in touch with us, ideally via the class emails, regularly, so that we know you are O.K. and so that we can continue to find ways to support you and your family.

We are in the process of setting up links within Google Suite and adding some personal introductions to sessions from our staff. We will keep you updated.
